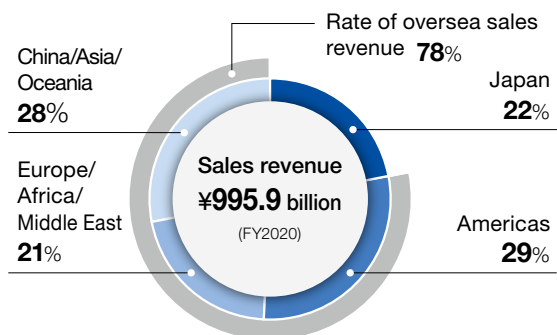

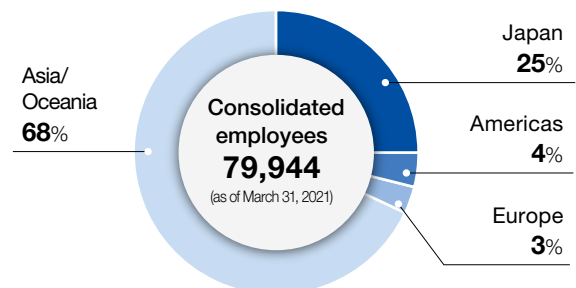

### ■ Employees by region (consolidated)



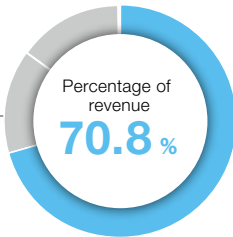

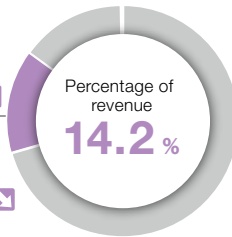

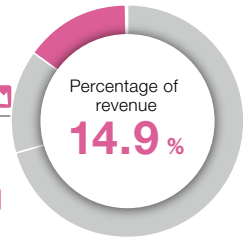
